### **Conditions for lectures in walk-in theatres**

#### **Wednesday 11 and Thursday 12 October 2017 – Hart van Holland - Nijkerk**

Exhibitors will have an opportunity to deliver a lecture.

Lectures should concern subjects including research, novelties, new working methods, solutions for certain problems, new insights, etc. Commercial lectures on your company's own business or products are not permitted. The presentation should be informative.

#### **Duration**

Lectures may last a maximum of 20 minutes. A maximum of 5 minutes extra will be reserved for discussion or to answer questions. Lectures will be delivered at the following times (subject to change):

**11/10: 9.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. (details to be decided depending on participation)**

**12/10: 9.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. (details to be decided depending on participation)**

Participation and times will be allocated by the organisers.

#### **Registration**

You can give notice of your lecture by completing the Speakers Registration Form. The NSTT No-Dig Event Commission will make a selection on the basis of all submissions. Register before 1 June 2017.

#### **Resources**

The NSTT will make a separate room available with space for at least 30 persons, including audio equipment, a laptop and a beamer with a screen.

Speakers may provide hand-outs for visitors to the presentation.

#### **Submission of presentations**
